

## DIVERSITY OF CENTRAL OREGON ENROLLED K-12



In 2022, the national unemployment rate was **3.5%.** For those with only a high school diploma, their unemployment rate was **4.0%** 

For individuals who had obtained an **Associate's** (two-year) degree as their highest educational achievement, their unemployment rate was 2.7%.

For individuals who had obtained a **Bachelor's** (**four-year**) **degree** as their highest educational achievement, their unemployment rate was **2.2%**.

In 2021, for 25- to 34-year-olds who worked full time, year-round, higher educational attainment was associated with higher median earnings.

The median annual earnings of high school diploma completers was \$39,700.

The median annual earnings of Associate's degree completers was \$45,000.

The median annual earnings of Bachelor's degree completers was \$61,600.

A 2021 Georgetown University Center on Education and the Workforce report found median lifetime earnings of full-time workers by level of education:

High school diploma: \$1.6 million

Associate's degree: **\$2 million,** equivalent to \$50k annually

Bachelor's degree: **\$2.8 million**, equivalent to \$70k annually
